

RESOLUTION NO. 26 - 32

A RESOLUTION AMENDING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES AT THE ASOTIN COUNTY REGIONAL LANDFILL

WHEREAS, the County owns and operates the Asotin County Regional Landfill; and

WHEREAS, landfill customers include communities in Asotin County (the City of Asotin, City of Clarkston, and unincorporated Asotin County), the City of Pomeroy and Garfield County, Washington, the City of Lewiston, Nez Perce County and Clearwater County, Idaho, contracted waste haulers; and

WHEREAS, solid waste disposal fees were most recently amended by Resolutions 15-35 and 25-39; and

WHEREAS, Asotin County diverts tire waste from the active landfill areas by requiring all tires to be segregated from other waste prior to dumping in accordance with Resolution 25-39 procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that solid waste disposal fees at the Asotin County Regional Landfill are revised as follows:

Appliances with Refrigerants	Each	\$30.00	\$1.08	\$31.08
All other Appliances	Each	\$10.00	\$0.36	\$10.36

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above fee changes be adopted as written, become effective on January 1, 2027, and remain in effect until changed by resolution.

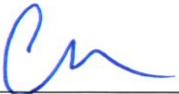
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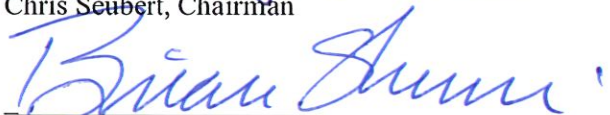
